On June 26th, 2020, an individual staying at Ronald McDonald House New York (RMH-NY) tested positive for COVID-19. The individual and their family members remain quarantined and isolated in place. RMH-NY has taken extensive precautionary measures already to minimize potential exposure to both families and staff. With these measures in place already, the House feels confident that there was little to no exposure to anyone in House besides the family at this time.

RMH-NY continues to follow the guidance and recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the New York State and New York City Departments of Health, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center and each of our partnering hospitals. We are closely monitoring this situation to ensure the health and well-being of our families, staff, and volunteers as they remain our top priority.
